BEA109 Introduction to Quantitative Methods

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

At the end of Semester 3, students must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.67 or higher. Students with a GPA between 2.40 – 2.66 may be accepted into this unit on conditional enrolment.

FEES

The fee for BEA109 Introduction to Quantitative Methods is KD500. In addition, text books must be purchased. Please note that ACK reserves the right to increase fees for future academic years.

ADMISSION & PREREQUISITES - BACHELOR OF BUSINESS

To enroll in the Bachelor of Business program students must have successfully completed the two-year Diploma of Management, Diploma of Business Management (Hospitality) or Diploma of Marketing and BEA109 Introduction to Quantitative Methods with a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.67 or higher.

Students with a GPA between 2.40 – 2.66 may be accepted into this course on conditional enrolment.
